

Appendix A - Restricted, prohibited and illegal articles

1. Restricted articles

The following items are defined as restricted articles within a youth detention centre:

- s73(2)
- [redacted]
- stationary
- [redacted]
- computers and telecommunication equipment (e.g. mobile phones, USB sticks, portable music players, cameras & etc.)
- any other item that the executive director determines to be restricted.

2. Prohibited articles

The following items are defined as prohibited articles within a youth detention centre:

- pornographic material
- articles that may be culturally, racially or culturally offensive to others (posters, drawings & etc.)

- unauthorised computer or telecommunication equipment
- an objectionable computer game under the *Classification of Computer Games and Images Act 1995*
- any film with a classification rating greater than M under the *Classification of Films Act 1991*
- a prohibited publication under the *Classification of Publications Act 1991*

- any other item that the centre director determines to be prohibited.
